DO I QUALIFY?

- ✔ You're a homeowner in Manitoba.
- ✔ You're over the age of 18 and own the appliance(s) being recycled.

DOES MY APPLIANCE QUALIFY?

- ✔ It's in a residential single-family property or condo (seasonal properties, apartments, and businesses don't qualify).
- ✔ It's at least 20 years old and 10 cubic feet or larger.
- ✔ It's in working condition and capable of cooling.
- ✔ It's in its original location and plugged in at the time of pick-up.

We'll accept up to three full-sized fridges and/or freezers per household.

WHO WILL TAKE AWAY MY APPLIANCE?

Our trusted service provider, PureSphera Recovery and Recycling, will pick up your appliance and make sure it's recycled in an environmentally-friendly way.

WE TAKE SMALLER APPLIANCES, TOO.

If you recycle an eligible fridge or freezer, we can also take your old working dehumidifier, window air conditioner, bar fridge, and/or undersized freezer off your hands. Even though they're not eligible for a \$30 rebate, you'll still benefit from free pick-up and recycling!

DID YOU KNOW?

- The average fridge manufactured in 1990 uses approximately 1,400 kWh of electricity. That one fridge could cost you around \$120 per year to operate!
- Most fridges manufactured before 1995 contain chlorofluorocarbons (CFCs), also known as Freon. Freon is a powerful greenhouse gas that can destroy the ozone layer, which protects us against the sun's harmful UV rays. That's why it's so important to safely dispose of fridges.
