POSITION OVERVIEW

Under the direction of the DSM Planning & Corporate Performance Manager, you will be responsible for the analysis and reporting of DSM program achievements and key corporate performance metrics, along with coordinating external evaluation contracts. You will be required to demonstrate solid financial, analytical, organizational, and communication skills combined with technical DSM knowledge.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Effectively coordinate the contract with Efficiency Manitoba's legislated independent assessor of DSM programs including facilitating communication and information transfer between the independent assessor and Efficiency Manitoba program and technical staff.
- Coordinate regular and ad hoc internal and external reporting of actual/achieved program energy savings while collaborating with Efficiency Manitoba Accounting to report on costs.

- Produce reports for leadership communication to the Board of Directors and external stakeholders on Efficiency Manitoba's performance.
- Monitor, report, and make recommendations contributing to continuous improvement and ongoing key performance indicator progress.
- Provide guidance to program and technical staff on appropriate evaluation methodologies and assumptions to be used for programs and program evaluation plans.
- Coordinate Efficiency Manitoba's participation in the Provincial regulatory accountability (Red Tape reduction) initiative including coordination of internal resources and input, along with tracking and reporting.
- Liaise with external consultants, market research suppliers, and other program administrators and utilities on issues related to DSM evaluation.

REQUIREMENTS

- A four-year Bachelor's degree majoring in Marketing, Finance, Accounting or Economics and two years of directly related experience demonstrating the skills and abilities required by this position.
- Demonstrated experience in economic and financial analysis.
- Good understanding of program design and evaluation principles, economic analysis, and market transformation concepts as they apply to DSM products and services.
- Demonstrated aptitude in the use Microsoft Office (Word, Excel, PowerPoint, Access) particularly in working in large and complex spreadsheets with strong attention to detail.
